

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

Drilled well, equipped with pump and motor, pipelines, pumping stations, and storage reservoirs. 12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use. This application and any others filed in this basin by Washoe County are to appropriate all of the unappropriated groundwater. The diversion is anticipated to exceed the perennial yield of the basin for limited periods of time. This limited duration over-pumpage will provide a supplemental supply of water to augment the quasi-municipal use of surface water during droughts or other short-term emergencies and to fill reservoirs. The 20-year average consumptive use will not exceed the perennial yield of the groundwater basin. To allow the basin to replenish its storage by natural means, the normal (non-drought period) consumptive use will be about 80 to 90 percent of the estimated perennial yield. This water will be commingled with other waters appropriated by Washoe County to serve a county-wide population of 500,000 by the year 2030.
