6. Place of use Portion of the NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 and NW 1/4 of SW 1/4, Sec. 19, T 19 N R 29 E, MDB&M; also, known as the Carson River Estates Subdivision in Fallon, Nevada. (Subdivision to consist of 33 residences.)
7. Use will begin about Jan 1st and end about Dec. 31st, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water will be diverted with pump and motor from proposed 8" well to existing subdivision.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

No perforations shall be put in the production casing from ground level to 100 feet.

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The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and

not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 12.045 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 12, 1988

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before February 12, 1988

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 12, 1989

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 12, 1989

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 12, 1989
