The applicant Arthur L. Jones Snr., Barbara A. Jones, Arthur L. Jones Jr., and Debra L. Jones, of 424 Randal, Star Route 1, Hawthorne, Nevada 89415, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.04 second-feet
3. The water to be used for irrigation
4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated 1.60
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point unsurveyed Portion of Government Lot 2, Sec. 9, T9N, R29E, M.D.B.&M. or at a point from survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. which the S.W. corner of said Government Lot 2, bears S 43° 27' 38" W, a distance of 1558.2' (feet)
6. Place of use Portion of Govt. Lot 2, Sec 9, T9N, R29E, M.D.B.&M. Easterly portion of Lot 2 is unsurveyed. (Relinquished by receding shoreline of Walker Lake.)
7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st of each year.
8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled well with pump and motor
9. Estimated cost of works \$10,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works. Existing domestic well to be converted to irrigation use
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use. 3 years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed.

The place of use under this permit is limited to irrigate only the common areas within the Walker Lakeside Manor Subdivision, Units 1 and 2, referenced by Review No. 3229F-1 dated October 29, 1986 and Review No. 3229F-2 dated April 13, 1987.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued for a duty of 6.4 acre feet annually for the irrigation of the common area and up to 1800 gallons per day for the domestic use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and

not to exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources, but not to exceed 8.42 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 23, 1992

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before March 23, 1992

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 23, 1994

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 23, 1994

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 23, 1994
