APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 22060, Certificate 6119 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 22060, Certificate 6119 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 50520 and 50521 shall not exceed 1928.66 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If this permit is cancelled or withdrawn, the water reverts to the source and not the base right.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not

to exceed 1.78 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources, but not to exceed 1288.66 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 20, 1988

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 20, 1988

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 20, 1990

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 20, 1990

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 20, 1990
