APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant The United States of America, United States Department of Agriculture, Forest Service

hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Daggett Creek

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.5 cfs (40 MGA) second-foot

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Commercial-snowpack augmentation

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 31, T.13 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 31 bears South 68°44' West, 1735 feet.

6. Place of use Portions of the S 1/2 Section 30, Portions of the W 1/2 Section 31, T.13 N., R.19 E.; portions of the SE 1/4 Section 36, T.13 N., R.18 E.; portions of the NE 1/4 Section 1, T.12 N., R.18 E.; and NW 1/4 Section 6, T.12 N., R.19 E., M.D.B. & M., as shown on the supporting map.

7. Use will begin about Nov. 2 of each year and end about March 14 of the following year, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Dam, proposed reservoir and pumping and pipeline distribution system for snow making equipment.

9. Estimated cost of works \$100,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works Three (3) years
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use Five (5) years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use. Water under this appropriation is to be commingled with water applied for under Application 50039. Water will be stored in a proposed reservoir in the fall for snowmaking during the winter ski season. This appropriation is for the period of time which is not subject to irrigation use under the State Decree, dated February 13, 1974, on Daggett Creek. APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.5 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The use and storage of water under this permit shall be limited to the period between November 2, of one year to March 14, of the next.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 40 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 17, 1989

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 17, 1989

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 17, 1991

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 17, 1991

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
