Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit #21474 Cert. 6877

(Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed .0361 (18.48 ac.ft.) Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation & Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Same Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 6, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 6 distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. bears S. 86° 00' 00" W., a distance of 3300 ft.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 9, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec. 9 bears N. 56° 3' E., a distance of 3134.04 ft.

7. Proposed place of use SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Sec. 6 and the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Sec. 7, all in T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M. (Portions) 4.62

8. Existing place of use 38 Acres, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 9, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M. 38 Acres, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 9, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M. 36 Acres, SW 1/4 M.D.B.&M. Area being removed is Lt. 6 of Golden Bee Subdivision. Being a portion of SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 9, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.

9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled well, pump & irrigation system.

12. Estimated cost of works \$10,000.00

13. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 21474, Certificate 6877 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 21474, Certificate 6877 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 50544 and 50545 shall not exceed 19.44 acre-feet annually.

This permit is limited to the irrigation of 4.62 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0361 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 18.48 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 7, 1989

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 7, 1989

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 7, 1991

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 7, 1991

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 7, 1991
