waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) January 1984 Helena, Montana

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is artesian water in alluvial fan of Delamar Valley below Cedar Wash demonstrated by two MX Siting wells in 12-6S-63E.

2. The amount of water applied for is up to one second-foot to assure future requirements (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for mining

4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered (c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks") (d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed (2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point section 12, T. 6 S., R. 63 E. 2080 feet S. 20° W. of the surveyed SW corner of sec. 6, T. 6 S., R. 64 E. or from wells drilled upslope in that vicinity.

6. Place of use Delamar Mine, approximate center of section 1, T. 6 S., R. 64 E.

7. Use will begin about probably year-round and end about of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) pumped from well or wells via pipeline to storage tank at the mine.

9. Estimated cost of works \$80,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works two months
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use six months

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

Water to be used for a proposed heap-leach operation at the Delamar Mine, and if sufficient reserves are developed, for a large mill plus domestic use by employees. Estimated annual consumptive use: (a) heap leach: 22 acre-feet; (b) mill: 100 acre-feet.
