hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion, Manner of Use, and Place of Use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit Number 11421 - Certificate Number 3378

- 1. The source of water is Las Vegas Artesian Basin (Underground)
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.40 c.f.s. or not to exceed 20 acre feet per year
3. The water to be used for Municipal Purposes
4. The water heretofore permitted for Quasi - Municipal Purposes
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, T.19S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the north 1/2 corner of said Section 33, bears N 31° 47' 43" W a distance of 1334.86.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 28, T.20S., R. 61E., M.D.B.&M. OR AT A POINT FROM WHICH THE West 1/2 corner of said Section 28, bears S42° 09' 59" W a distance of 1517,78' feet.
7. Proposed place of use See Attached Sheet
8. Existing place of use NW 1/4 Section 28, T.20S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M. within lots 7, 8, and the southerly 25' of lots 6 and 19 in Block 5 of Bonanza Village Tract as shown in Book of Plats Page 69.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) 12" Diameter well bored to a depth of 700' with 231' of 8" casing. A 15 HP 109 GPM pump, 30 KW generator and misc. piping.
12. Estimated cost of works \$45,978.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works Now completed

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... One (1) year

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 11421, Certificate 3378 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 11421 Certificate 3378 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.4 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 6.52 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 25, 1989

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 25, 1989

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 25, 1991

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 25, 1991

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
