

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Division of State Parks

201 South Fall Street, of Carson City

Nevada 89710, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public

waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Left Fork Spring (this application is for increase in appropriation and change in place of use, existing permit #37005)

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.056 cfs (25 gpm) second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for recreation, domestic, and wildlife

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point NE1/4 NE1/4, Section 27, T.12N.

R.39E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 27, T.12N.,

R.39E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 48° 28' W., a distance of 6,799.60 feet.

6. Place of use The NE1/4 and NE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 33; the SE1/4 and the W1/2 of

Section 28, The W1/2 NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 34; the E1/2 of Section 29; all within

T.12N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M. Also the NW1/4 SW1/4 and the NE1/4 SW1/4 and the NE1/4 and

the W1/2 SW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 27, T.12N., R.39E.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and

specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Spring collection box, 5200 feet of 2"

PVC waterline, 25,000 gallons of storage flumes, drilled well with pump and motor, etc.

9. Estimated cost of works \$95,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works Three (3) months  
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use Two (2) years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

Twenty-five (25) unit campground, day use areas, ranger residence and office, and visitor center. Overflow at the spring site will provide water for wildlife. Berlin Ichthyosaur State Park.

APPROVAL \_\_\_\_\_ OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.056 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 37005, Certificate 10379 and 51291 shall not exceed 1.758 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.056 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1.64 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 7, 1989

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before May 7, 1989

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 7, 1991

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 7, 1991

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A


