of water heretofore appropriated under Claims or Rights No. 477 and 479 Equity Docket A-3. (Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and

1. The source of water is as decreed, Truckee River Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 150 acre feet per season Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for recreation, golf course Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for as decreed Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 16 T19N, R18E, Mount Diablo Maridian at a point from which the distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. Northeast corner of said Section 16 bears North 75°16' East 1,650 feet distance (known as the Highland Ditch Diversion Dam)

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11 T19N, R19E, Mount Diablo Maridian at a point from which the Southwest corner of said Section 11 bears South 65°23' West, 3,900 feet distance (known as the Cochran Ditch Diversion Dam)

7. Proposed place of use portions of the following: Section 1 and Section 12 T19N, R18E Mount Diablo Maridian and West half Section 7, T19N, R19E, Mount Diablo Maridian containing 265.26 acres (known as Northgate Golf Course)

8. Existing place of use a portion of the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, T19N, R20E, Mount Diablo Maridian containing 37.5 acres.

9. Use will be from as decreed to of each year.

10. Use was permitted from as decreed to of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) existing Highland Diversion Dam sytem, pump, pipeline and storage pond

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claims 477 and 479 Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.938 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 150 acre feet as decreed.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 22, 1991

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 22, 1991

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 22, 1993

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 22, 1993

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 22, 1993
