hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

A Nevada Corporation; November 4, 1987

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Infiltration Well (Surface) Trail Creek

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.05 cfs second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Mining and Milling (Placer Gold Operation)

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, T. 44 N, R 53 E., MDB & M., at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 20 bears N 26° 30' 00" E, 718.00 feet.

6. Place of use NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20; NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21, T 44 N, R 53 E, MDB & M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Infiltration well, pipelines, 20'x20' storage pond, placer gold plant and two 20'x20' percolation ponds.

9. Estimated cost of works \$100,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works..... 3 years
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... 5 years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

This application is for nonconsumptive use except for evaporation from one 20' x 20' storage pond (loss of 48" per year equals 11,970 gallons annually). The waters are to be returned to the ground through two 20' x 20' percolation ponds so that no muddy waters will be introduced to any surface drainage.
