1. The source of water is underground

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 19 Township 8 North Range 44 East M.D.B.&M. at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 19 bears North 87°20'15" West a distance of 1900.68 feet.
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19 Township 8 North Range 44 East, at a point from which the East quarter corner of Section 19 bears South 49°59'06" East a distance of 1795.64 feet.
If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

7. Proposed place of use within the South 1/2 and the South 1/2 North 1/2 Section 19 Township 8 North Range 44 East, M.D.B.&M.
Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use within the South 1/2 and the South 1/2 North 1/2 Section 19 Township 8 North Range 44 East, M.D.B.&M.

9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 49683 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 49683 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 27860, Certificate 10018; 30805, Certificate 11990; 35884, Certificate 11387; 35917, Certificate 11388; 40421, 40422, 41196, Certificate 11414; 41938, 41939, 41940, 41941, 41942, 49683, 52069, 52070, 52526 and 52527 shall not exceed 290.875 million gallons annually.

This permit is issued under the preferred use provisions of NRS Chapter 534. The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be (CONTINUED ON PAGE 2)

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.4 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 94.388 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 24, 1990

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 24, 1990

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 24, 1991

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 24, 1991

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
