Nevada 89104, hereby make.s application for permission to appropriate the public

waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) DUMPCO, Inc. is a Nevada Corporation incorporated in Carson City, Nevada, April 5, 1985.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is treated effluent from Clark County Sanitation District Sewage Treatment Plant.

2. The amount of water applied for is 100 AF/yr second-foot (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet 100 AF/year stored under Primary Permit 52099.

3. The water to be used for dust control/compaction control at landfill site.

4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated: N/A (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered: N/A (c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks" SEE ITEM 12 (d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed N/A (2) Point of return of water to stream N/A

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 14, T.21S., R.62E., or at a point whence the SW corner of said Section 14 bears S. 41°31'00"W. a distance of 1023.0 feet.

6. Place of use 160 acres within the SE 1/4 Section 1, T21S., R62E., plus 560 acres within Section 12, T.21S., R62E. as follows: The NE 1/4 (160A.), The SE 1/4 (160A.), The SW 1/4 (160A.) and the East 1/2 of the NW 1/4 (80A.), a total of 720 acres.

7. Use will be begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water will be truck transported (10,000 Gal Truck) from the point of diversion to the place of use.

9. Estimated cost of works \$58,000 (See Primary Permit 52099)

10. Estimated time required to construct works. Already constructed. Water will be drawn from

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use. 2 years

This application is for a secondary permit to use the waters appropriated under permit 52099. Water will be used for dust control and as a compaction aid at the Sunrise Landfill, Las Vegas, Nevada.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This secondary permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions under Permit 52099. The granting of this permit is not intended in any way to waive or affect authority or requirements of appropriate water quality control agencies or regulations. This permit is further issued subject to the provisions of NRS 533.395 and specifically subject to the Notice of Availability of Effluent dated August 24, 1989.

The permit granted herein carries with it no provision or guarantee for the continuous availability or effluent and the State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 100 acre-feet annually. ~~cubic feet per second~~
