Point of diversion and Place of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 30108, Certificate 10578

Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.

1. The source of water is underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.1008 CFS (16 acre feet) Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 22, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the Southeast corner of said Section distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. 22 bears S.40°39'32"E. a distance of 2568.8 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 32, T.23N., R.21E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the Southwest corner of said Section distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. 32 bears S.41°59'42"W. a distance of 3915.67 feet (well 1).

7. Proposed place of use Section 22, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.M.: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 - 4.0 ac. Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use Section 6, T.22N., R.21E., M.D.M.: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 - 3.6 ac; NE 1/4 NE 1/4 - 0.4 ac - total 4.0 ac. as depicted as Parcel 1 on Exhibit Map Supporting the conveyance of Water Rights by MCO Properties Inc. - Palomino Valley, Nevada, filed with the Nevada State Engineer on February 19, 1986.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30108, Certificate 10578 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30108, Certificate 10578 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.1008.....cubic feet per second., and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources, but not to exceed 16 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... November 27, 1990

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before..... December 27, 1990

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before..... November 27, 1991

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before..... December 27, 1991
