APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 50940 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 50940 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

No perforations shall be put in the production casing from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 50688, 50939, 51074, 51750, 51963, 52354, 52795, 52796 and 52797 shall not exceed 420.48 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 70.08 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 10, 1989

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 10, 1989

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 10, 1991

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 10, 1991

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
