- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Sharon Spring
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.5 second-feet
3. The water to be used for mining milling and domestic
4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated...
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 15 T 8N R 28E M. D. M.
6. Place of use Forthright lode and placer mining claims, a portion to the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4 OF Section 15; SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 16; all in Township 8 North Range 28 East M.D.M.
7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) storage ponds, pipes and pump.
9. Estimated cost of works \$5,000.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years

Water to serve for processing and milling of ores from two lode claims and two 40 acre placer claims. Estimated total annual use will be 10,500,000 gallons per year or 20 GPM per day continuous operation 24 hrs per day 7 days per week.
