This is to certify I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby ~~grant~~ the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This application is herewith denied on the grounds that to grant an application for irrigation purposes on lands that the applicant does not own or control, and where the applicant cannot demonstrate the ability to place the water to beneficial use, would be detrimental to the public interest and welfare. In addition, to grant an application to change water granted for quasi-municipal purposes to irrigation purposes in a basin where irrigation was being denied at the time of the original appropriation would not be in the public interest.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed.....cubic feet per second.....

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before.....

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before.....

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before.....
