The applicant **PRO-MAX CORP.**, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **underground**
2. The amount of water applied for is **1.0** second-feet
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre -feet
3. The water to be used for **quasi-municipal and domestic**
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")
 - (d) Power:
 - (1) Horsepower developed
 - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 20,, T19N, R18E, being N 35°44'00" E, 2435 feet to the NE corner of said Section 20.**
6. Place of Use **T19N, R18E, MDB&M, Sec 17; Lot 2 and Lot 4, the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$. Excepting therefrom 12 acres lying North and West of Steamboat Ditch as described in a Deed recorded in Book 18, page 280, Deed Records. T19N, R18E, MDB&M, Sec 16; the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$. T19N, R18E, MDB&M, Sec 20; the E $\frac{1}{2}$, the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$. SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 17.**
7. Use will begin about **January 1** and end about **December 31**, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **Drilled and cased well, submersible pump, electric motor, storage tank and distribution system.**
9. Estimated cost of works **\$850,000**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **3 years**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **7 years**


