The applicant LAS VEGAS VALLEY WATER DISTRICT, a Quasi-Municipal Corporation 3700 West Charleston Boulevard of Las Vegas, Nevada, 89153 hereby make application for permission to change the

point of diversion and place of use, and manner of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 42814 map filed under Permit No. 42814 on March 21, 1981

- 1. The source of water is underground - Ivanpah Valley Groundwater Basin
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.264 cfs (191.210 acre-feet per annum)
3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for Quasi-Municipal (subdivision, commercial) and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 9, T.25S., R.59E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 11, T.25S., R.59E., M.D.B.&M. bears distance to a section corner.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 12, T.25S., R.59E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 12 bears S. 67° 52' 30" W. a distance of 1,155 feet.
7. Proposed place of use See attachment
8. Existing place of use portions of the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 12, T.25S., R.59E., M.D.B.&M. and a portion of the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, T.25S., R.59E., M.D.B.&M. Place of use map filed under Permit No. 42814 dated March 21, 1981.
9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) N/A Existing
12. Estimated cost of works N/A Existing
13. Estimated time required to construct works water is to be diverted from an existing 12-inch cased well approximately 1,300 feet deep known as the "Gold Strike Well" via an existing deep well pump, pipelines, reservoirs and distribution system.

- 14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use.....quantity applied for combined with existing water rights provides for projected demands to the year 1996.
- 15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use. This application is to change the point of diversion and place of use, and manner of use of a 191.210 acre-feet per annum portion (original quantity being 499.684 acre-feet per annum) of application No. 42814 originally applied for by Peter A. Simon, II, on November 12, 1980 and purchased by the Las Vegas Valley Water District as a part of the Acquisition of Jean Utility Services, Inc. on April 16, 1985 as evidenced by a Quitclaim Deed recorded in Book 870701, Instrument No. 532 in the Clark County Recorder's Office on July 1, 1987. Water is to be used for service to Town, Prison, Hotels and Casinos at Jean, Nevada.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 42814 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 42814 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 17691, Certificate 6058, 21997, Certificate 8278, 51133, 51543, 51544, 52732, 52733 and 52734 shall not exceed 212.90 million gallons annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.264cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 62.277 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... March 7, 1990.....

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before..... April 7, 1990.....

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before..... March 7, 1993.....

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before..... April 7, 1993.....
