1. The source of water is Truckee River via Steamboat Ditch.

2. The amount of water to be changed .44 miners inches, .011 cubic feet per second, not to exceed 1.062 acre feet annually.

3. The water to be used for irrigation.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, T19N, R19E, MDB&M, Washoe County at the South Side of the Truckee River (South Side Canal).
If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.
7. Proposed place of use 2.605 acres in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and 4.405 acres in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4; Section 18, T18N, R20E, MDB&M.

8. Existing place of use .25 acres in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, T19N, R19E, MDB&M. (.25 acres to be removed from irrigation).
