TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant U.S.D.I., Bureau of Land Management, c/o Ron Wenker,
705 E. Fourth St., of Winnemucca,
Nevada 89445, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public
waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorpora-
tion; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is McDermitt Fire Station Well (underground)
2. The amount of water applied for is 1.0 second-foot
3. The water to be used for quasi-municipal (Fire Station)
4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated; (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered; (c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks" see 12.; (d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed; (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NE 1/4-NW 1/4 of Section 16, T. 47 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from the NE 1/4 corner of said Section 16. Bears survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. N. 59° 34' 03" E. a distance of 1400.17'.
6. Place of use NE 1/4 NW 1/4 & Lot 1 and of section 16, T. 47 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M.
7. Use will be begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) drilled well with submergible pump and water system including pressure tank and lines
9. Estimated cost of works \$31,215 (well \$17,715, water system \$13,500)

10. Estimated time required to construct works October, 1989
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use October, 1991

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water place to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

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The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1.095 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 28, 1990

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 28, 1990

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 28, 1992

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 28, 1992

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
