Point of diversion and place of use
of water heretofore appropriated under permit no. 49783
Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use

- 1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.50 second feet
3. The water to be used for Mining
4. The water heretofore permitted for Mining
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, Section 18 T 14N R 25E M. D. M., from which point the SW corner of said Section 18 bears S 88 degrees 46' 30" W a distance of 1179.04 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4, Section 18 T 14N R 25E M.D.M., from which point the SW corner of said Section 18 bears S 69 degrees 17' 58" W a distance of 2746.28 feet.
7. Proposed place of use 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec 13 T 14N R 24E; 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 SE 1/4, 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec 24 T 14 N R 24E; SE 1/4 Sec 23 T 14N R 24E; NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, N 1/4 SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec 26 T 14N R 24E; Mount Diablo Meridian.
8. Existing place of use SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec 18 T 14N R 25E; NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec 19 T 14N R 25E; S 1/4 SE 1/4, Sec 13 T 14N R 24E; Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Submersible pump with below ground discharge. Pedestal mount electrical service entrance.
12. Estimated cost of works \$15,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 1 year

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... 2 years

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

Application is for a mining operation on the Judge & Nugget claims located in item 7 above. The type of plant, annual operating time and precise unit volume requirements cannot be determined until exploration and testing is completed. No change in annual consumptive rate is requested at this time.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 49783 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 49783 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is issued under the preferred use provisions of NRS Chapter 534. The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 19.5 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 24, 1990

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 24, 1990

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 24, 1991

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 24, 1991

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
