1. The source of water is Three Springs Creek

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place and manner of use of the waters of Three Springs Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 10218, Certificate 2762 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 10218, Certificate 2762 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.09 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 27.49 acre feet seasonally.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 22, 1991

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 22, 1991

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 22, 1993

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 22, 1993

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
