point of diversion and place of use of a portion
of water heretofore appropriated under permit 30109 certificate 10579

1. The source of water is underground

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.2000 cfs 20 acre feet

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30109, Certificate 10579 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30109, Certificate 10579 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is limited to the irrigation of 5.0 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.20 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 20.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 29, 1994

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 29, 1995

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 29, 1996

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 29, 1997

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 29, 1997

Completion of work filed MAY 23 1995

Proof of beneficial use filed
