Water will be used on 157.98 acres of Golf Course Fairways and related areas and 40.54 surface acres of small reservoirs. All water utilized on the Golf Course will be pumped via the reservoirs. As effluent becomes available the reservoirs will be used as mixing zones. As sufficient effluent becomes available the fresh water permits will be converted to Quasi-Municipal.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 13020, Certificate 5581 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 13020, Certificate 5581 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.66641 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 243.14 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 30, 1991

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 30, 1991

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 30, 1991

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 30, 1991
