The applicant **Northwest Nevada Water Resources Limited Partnership**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion and Place of Use** of water heretofore appropriated under **Permit 31200**

1. The source of water is **Underground**
2. The amount of water to be changed **1.9 c.f.s.**
3. The water to be used for **Irrigation and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **Irrigation and Domestic**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, T.26N., R.18E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the E $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 25 bears North 88°27'44" East, a distance of 3,804.82 feet**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, T.26N., R.18E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 16, T.26N., R.18E., MDB&M bears South 82°00'00" West, 6211.90 feet.**
7. Proposed place of use **Portions SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15; S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25, T.26N., R.18E., MDB&M (110 acres total to be irrigated)**
8. Existing place of use **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ portions NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, T.26N., R.18E., MDB&M (110 acres)**
9. Use will be from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
10. Use was permitted from **January 1 to December 31** of each year.
11. Description of proposed works **Drilled well, pump, water transmission pipeline and sprinkler system.**
12. Estimated cost of works **\$150,000.00**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **one year**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **two years**
15. Remarks: **The change hereby applied for is necessitated by poor ground-water aquifer production at the location of the existing point of diversion. Please use map filed under Permit 31200 to support the existing point of diversion and place of use, the map filed under Permit 49373 to support the proposed point of diversion, and maps filed under both Permits 31200 and 49373 to support the proposed place of use. The proposed point of diversion is the same as that under Permits 49709, 49373, 49376, and 49378. The total acreage to be irrigated under this application will not exceed 110 acres.**

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 31200 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 31200 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued subject to any reserved rights of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe of Indians, if they are found by an appropriate court to exist.

Any well drilled under Permit 31200 shall be plugged in accordance with the Nevada Administrative Code, Chapter 534.420, "Regulations for Water Well and Related Drilling" within 60 days from the issuance of this permit.

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.9 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 440.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

December 23, 1998

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

January 23, 1999

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

December 23, 1999

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

January 23, 2000

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

January 23, 2000
