hereby make application for permission to change the

Point of Diversion

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 51550 (Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 2.5 c.f.s. Second feet; acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation & Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation & Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 1, T. 35 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of Section 6, T. 35 N., R. 24 E., distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. M.D.B. & M. bears S. 63° 24' 10" E. a distance of 2961.21 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 1, T. 35 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 1 bears S. 87° 57' E. a distance of 946 feet.

7. Proposed place of use S 1/4 and lots 10, 11, 12, 13, 6, 7, 8 and 9, Section 1 T. 35 N., R. 23 E., M.D.B. & M.

8. Existing place of use Unchanged Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled and cased well, feeder lines to wheel lines.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 51550 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 51550 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 51551 and 53334-T shall not exceed 2592.7 acre-feet annually.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to Chapter 149 of the Statutes of Nevada 1989.

This temporary permit shall expire June 21, 1990 and all rights herein shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not

to exceed 2.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1262.32 acre-feet annually and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
