..... APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 28076, Certificate 8518 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 28076, Certificate 8518 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 53677 and 53678 shall not exceed 72.0 acre-feet annually.

The total combined acreage irrigated under Permits 53677 and 53678 is limited to 18.0 acres within the place of use as described.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.95456 cubic feet per second... but not to exceed 66.8 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.....

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... April 5, 1992.....

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before..... May 5, 1992.....

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before..... April 5, 1994.....
