Point of Diversion, Manner of Use and Place of Use.

1. The source of water is Underground

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.2875 cfs - not to exceed 208.13 A.F./yr.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 6, T18N, R20E, M.D.B. & M.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19, T18N, R20E, M.D.B. & M.,  
If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer  
or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 19 bears N 04° 30' E a distance of 2100.0 feet.
7. Proposed place of use water will be used within the Sierra Pacific Power Company water service area. A map of the service area, as approved by the Public Service Commission of Nevada, is on file at the Office of the State Engineer.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 49695 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 49695 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from each well and the amount of water used.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.2875 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 208.13 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 14, 1990.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 14, 1991.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 14, 1996.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 14, 1997.

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A.
