hereby make application for permission to change the

Manner of Use and Place of Use Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 31324, Certificate 11049 (Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

- 1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.32 c.f.s., not to exceed 11.33 million gallons annually
3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for Mining, Milling and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 12, T.16N., R.20E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 12 bears North 11°55' East, a distance of 890.0 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within

Proposed place of use NE 1/4, S 1/2 Section 24; NE 1/4, E 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 25; NE 1/4 NE 1/4, portion S 1/2 NE 1/4, portion NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 36; T.16N., R.20E., all of Section 19; SW 1/4 Section 20; W 1/2, SE 1/4, S 1/2 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 29; all of Section 30; N 1/2, portion N 1/2 SW 1/4, portion SE 1/4 SW 1/4, portion SE 1/4 Section 31; T.16N., R.21E., MDB&M. The Place of Use is not to include any area within Carson City County.
8. Existing place of use W 1/2 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 5, E 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 6, T.16N., R.21E., MDB&M.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled well, electric submersible pump, 1-million gallon storage tank, and distribution pipelines
12. Estimated cost of works completed
13. Estimated time required to construct works completed

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... 20 years

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

Please use map filed under Permit 31324 to support existing and proposed point of diversion and existing place of use. Use map filed under Permit 47997 to support the proposed place of use. Although located within the same place of use as existing supplemental American Flat Water Company water rights, the total annual duty under this application is to be additive to the existing system rights, thus increasing the total annual duty under Permit 52704 et. al. by 11.33 mga for service to an additional 31 parcels.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the place of use and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 31324, Certificate 11049 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 31324, Certificate 11049 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 24387, 24388, 24472, 25454, 25483, 25484, 26008, 27199, 42535, 42536, 42537, 42539, 42540, 42541, 43202, 46382, 46383, 46384, 46385, 46624, 46625, 48302, 48630, 48631, 48931, 48097, 48098, 48099, 48100, 48102, 48302, 48303, 48304, 48407, 48409, 49493, 49911, 49912, 50590, 50591, 50592, 50593, 50594, 50653, 51072, 51073, 52703, 52704 and 53738 shall not exceed 756.25 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.32 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 11.33 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 13, 1990

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 13, 1990

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 13, 1995

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 13, 1995

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 13, 1995
