Point of Diversion and Place of Use

of water heretofore appropriated under a portion of Permit No. 30109 - Certificate No. 10579

1. The source of water is underground

2. The amount of water to be changed. 0.0800 C.F.S. - 8.0 A.F.A.

3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic

4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation and domestic

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 21, T. 22 N., R. 21 E., M.D.M. from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 21 bears South 43°06'10" West, 1093.5 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 32, T. 23 N., R. 21 E., M.D.M. at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 32 bears South 41°59'42" West, 3915.67 feet (Well No. 1)

7. Proposed place of use NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 21, T. 22 N., R. 21 E., M.D.M. - 2.0 acres - Exact location to be determined later.

8. Existing place of use SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 32, T. 23 N., R. 21 E., M.D.M. 2.0 acres - Parcel 9 - as depicted and tabulated on that certain map entitled "Exhibit Map Supporting the Conveyance of Water Rights by MCO Properties, Inc. - Palomino Valley, Nevada" dated February 15, 1986, filed with the Nevada State Engineer on February 19, 1986.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well, pump and pipeline.

12. Estimated cost of works. \$20,000

13. Estimated time required to construct works. 3 years

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30109, Certificate 10579 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30109, Certificate 10579 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is limited to the irrigation of 2.0 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.080 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 8.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 22, 1996

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 22, 1996

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 22, 1999

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 22, 1999

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 22, 1999
