APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 54204 and 54205 shall not exceed 2082.3 acre-feet annually and is supplemental to all surface water rights within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

All surface water within the described place of use must be used for irrigation prior to the use of the ground water under Permits 54204 and 54205. The water under this permit is subject to the Determination in the Matter of the Adjudication of the Relative Rights in and to the Waters of Cleve Creek and Tributaries. Any water changed under this permit is limited to the amount of water that has been put to beneficial use for irrigation. Water under this permit is limited to the irrigation of 694.10 acres of previously irrigated land within the described place of use.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second and not to exceed 2082.3 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:
