6. Place of use Water will be discharged to the Las Vegas Sanitary Sewer near the well. In the North Parking Lot of the Union Plaza Hotel within the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of section 27 and the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 34, township 20 South, Range 61 East, M.O.B. & M., City of Las Vegas, Clark County Nevada

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and Water will be separated from product, if any, using a dual pumping system in the specifications of your diversion or storage works.) sump of a trench drain. This water will then be diverted through a water drain line to Las Vegas City Sewer System in the North Parking Lot of the Union Plaza Hotel. Periodic flumes, drilled well with pump and motor, etc. sampling will be performed to ensure quality of discharge.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued subject to existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance for pollution control as mandated by orders issued by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection and subsequent correspondence with said agency. The right will cease to exist upon termination of clean up activity as determined by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and records of this measurement shall be submitted on an annual basis. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level of permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water granted herein at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 23.59 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 27, 1992

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before July 27, 1992

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 27, 1995

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 27, 1995

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
