APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

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The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 71 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 19, 1992

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 19, 1992

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 19, 1994

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 19, 1994

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A

Completion of work filed APR 17 1992

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from each well and the amount of water used for mining and milling purposes.

The issuance of this permit does not establish any right, possessory or otherwise to specific mining claims or determine any boundary locations or disputes.

As specified in the map on file with the Division of Water Resources submitted by Sunland Limited Partnership on February 14, 1991, the place of use for Permit 54498 has been limited to portions within:
