

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant County of Elko (Community of Jarbidge) Elko County Courthouse, of Elko, Nevada 89801, hereby make... application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

(If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground (well) Name of stream, lake, spring, underground or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.23 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for (Community of Jarbidge) Quasi-Municipal Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 16, T 46N, R 58E Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public

MDB&M, S 0° 00'30" W. 2500 feet to SW corner of Section 16, T 46N, R 58E, survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

6. Place of use Townsite of Jarbidge, Nevada in W 1/2 W 1/2, Section 16, Township 46 North, Describe by legal subdivision. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

Range 58 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian in Elko County, Nevada.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month and Day

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) drilled well with pump and electric motor. State manner in which water is to be diverted, i.e. diversion structure, ditches and flumes, drilled well with pump and motor, etc.

9. Estimated cost of works \$123,000.

10. Estimated time required to construct works..... ten months.  
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... ten months.

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

The Community of Jarbidge has a population of approximately 100 during the summer and 15 during the winter. Average daily use is approximately 250 gallons per capita per day (GPCD). Maximum daily use is estimated at 500 GPCD. The County of Elko as the applicant will transfer the ownership of the well permit to the Jarbidge Water Users Association after the well is in operation.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to

exceed 0.23 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 56.01 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 25, 1993

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before April 25, 1993

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 25, 1995

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 25, 1995

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 25, 1995
