1. The source of water is Underground Well No. 2 Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 1.0 cfs Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Mining and Milling Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Mining and Milling Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 34, T37N, R49E, MDB & M., Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and at a point from which the SW corner of Section 3, T36N, R49E, MDB & M., distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. bears S 9° 46' 09" W, 5727.69 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 33, T37N, R49E, MDB & M., at a point from which the SW corner of Section 3, T36N, R49E, MDB & M., bears S 3° 48' 08" E, 5598.24 feet. If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

Proposed place of use SW 1/4, W 1/2 SE 1/4, Portions of NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 33; SE 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Portions of NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 34; SW 1/4 Section 35, T37N, R49E, MDB&M., NE 1/4 Section 4; N 1/2, SW 1/4 Section 3; N 1/2 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T36N, R49E, MDB & M. APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 53164 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 53164 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 45542, 45543, 47971, 51907, 53715 and 54566 shall not exceed 210.24 million gallons annually.

This permit is issued under the preferred use provisions of NRS Chapter 534. (CONTINUED ON PAGE 2)

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 210.24 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 3, 1991

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 3, 1991

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 3, 1992

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 3, 1992

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.
