Nevada 89704, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public

waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.15 c.f.s., not to exceed 0.2 mga second-foot

6. Place of use within portions of the E 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 11, T.14N., R.19E., MDB&M, as

shown on the supporting map (approximately 1.5 acres)

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and

specifications of your diversion or storage works.) drilled well, pump an motor, and distribution

system

9. Estimated cost of works \$5,000.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works..... 1 year

The water under this application is requested as a preferred use for expansion of existing facilities at the Jacks Valley Volunteer Fire Department. Uses will include bathroom facilities, landscaping to meet Douglas County Ordinances, washing of firetrucks and other incidental uses. Anticipated consumption is 500 gallons per day.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.15 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 0.2 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 9, 1994

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before December 9, 1994

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 9, 1996

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 9, 1996

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 9, 1996

Completion of work filed JAN 26 1996
