

DENIAL OF STATE ENGINEER

The protests to this application are hereby upheld in part and the application is hereby denied on the grounds that there is no unappropriated groundwater at the source of the supply, the proposed use would conflict with existing rights in the Order 1169 basins and the proposed use of the water would threaten to prove detrimental to the public interest in that it would threaten the water resources upon which the endangered Moapa dace are dependent. No ruling is made on the merits of the remaining protest grounds.

Nevada, 89151 hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

Incorporated in the State of Nevada in 1929

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground - California Wash Basin in Clark County, Nevada

2. The amount of water applied for is 3.5 second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Industrial Cooling and Environmental Control

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks") X

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point Within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 7

R.66E. T.15S, M.D.B.&M at a point from which the East 1/4 corner of said Section

7, bears South 78° 16' 57" East a distance of 3046.21 feet.

6. Place of use Portion of Section 5 T.15S. R.66E., M.D.B.&M. within the SW 1/4 and the

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 5

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water is to be diverted via a drilled well equipped with pump and motor thence via underground pipeline to the existing raw water ponds at Nevada Power's Reid Gardner Generating Sta.

9. Estimated cost of works \$500,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works 4 years
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 6 years
