APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of West Walker River as heretofore granted under Permit 5528, Certificate 8859 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 5528, Certificate 8859 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

With the issuance of this permit, the existing place of use described under this application must not be irrigated from any source.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 49250, 49251, 49323, 54419, 54420 and 54645 shall not exceed 954.36 acre-feet annually.

The period of use of this permit is limited to May 1st to July 1st of each year.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.2912 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a seasonal duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 1, 1991

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 1, 1991

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 1, 1992

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 1, 1992

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 1, 1992
