APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 18631, Certificate 5845 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 18631, Certificate 5845 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 54860 and 55759-T shall not exceed 764 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 624 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1991

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 1, 1991

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 1, 1992

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 1, 1992

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 1, 1992

The well at the point of diversion described under Permit 18631, Certificate 5845 shall be plugged within 15 days after the issuance of Permit 54860. The plugging of the well shall be done in accordance with the "Regulation for Water Well and Related Drilling".
