This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on October 20, 1990 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of King's Canyon Creek as heretofore appropriated under Civil Decree of November 14, 1885, (King's Canyon Creek, et. al.) in the District Court of the Second Judicial District of the State of Nevada in and for Carson City is hereby issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This temporary permit is subject to the water lease agreement between Ira R. Andersen and Jeanne E. Andersen and the City of Carson City dated April 20, 1990.

This temporary Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 31% of the total flow of ~~xxxxxx~~ cubic feet per second Kings Canyon Creek
