1. The source of water is from an underground source

2. The amount of water to be changed 1.43 cfs; 187.86 acre feet

3. The water to be used for Quasi-municipal purposes

4. The water heretofore permitted for Quasi-municipal purposes

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T12N, R21E, M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section bears S, 36° 41' 20" W., 124.70 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T12N, R21E, M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section bears S, 36° 41' 20" W., 124.70 feet.

7. Proposed place of use SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and E 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 35; S 1/2 NW 1/4, W 1/2 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4; SW 1/4 NE 1/4, W 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 36, T13N, R20E, M.D.B.&M.

8. Existing place of use S 1/2 NW 1/4, W 1/2 SW 1/4 NE 1/4, and the N 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 18, T12N, R21E, M.D.B.&M.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled well, pump and motor: completed

12. Estimated cost of works \$26,000

13. Estimated time required to construct works 380 feet deep. Drilled 12-inch gravel packed well, phase Franklin submersible motor, Red Jacket submersible pump, McCrometer totalizing flow meter, 4-inch, #784252.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 36511 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 36511 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.43 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 187.86 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 27, 1995

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 27, 1995

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 27, 2000

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 27, 2000

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

This permit is expressly issued for the purpose of providing water for the Wildflower Ridge Units 1 through 8, subdivision consisting of 93 units. The place of use of this permit must remain with the subdivision.

Any cancellation or withdrawal of this Permit, the right will revert to the source and not to the base right.

The issuance of this permit reduces the diversion rate and annual duty under Permit 36511 to 0.80 cfs and 33.9 million gallons, respectively.
