1. The source of water is UNDERGROUND Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.239 c.f.s. Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for IRRIGATION Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point In the NE 1/4, SE 1/4 of Section 33, T11N, R24E, M.D.M., From which point the East 1/4 Corner of Section 33, T11N, R24E, distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. M.D.M. Bears N 21° 10' 21" E, Distance 828.64' (within 300')

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within The NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 3, T10N, R24E, M.D.M. From which point the SE Corner of Section 34, T11N, R24E, M.D.M. Bears N 75° 15' E, 4900.6'.

7. Proposed place of use 20.00 Acres in the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4, Section 33, T11N, R24E, M.D.M. Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use SAME AS PROPOSED Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 16440, Certificate 4898 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 16440, Certificate 4898 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The period of use of this permit is limited to April 1 to September 15 of each year.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.239 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources, but not to exceed 80 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 27, 1993

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 27, 1993

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 27, 1996

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 27, 1996

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 27, 1996

Completion of work filed JAN 9 - 1995

Proof of beneficial use filed MAY 26 1999
