Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use Permit 4070, Certificate 657 of water heretofore appropriated under Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and

Identify right in Decree.

1. The source of water is South Fork Humboldt River (Hot Springs) Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed .0537 c.f.s. (19.33 AF) Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Recreation Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 4, T.32N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and or at a point from which the E 1/4 Corner of said Section 4 bears N. 60° 03' 19" E. distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. a distance of 2,654.49 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 21, T.34N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M. If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

Portions of S 1/2 Sec. 3; S 1/2 Sec. 4; NE 1/4 Sec. 9, All of Sec. 10; W 1/2 & SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 11; SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 13, Sec. 14; N 1/2 Sec. 15; NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 23; NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 24, portion of Sec. 25, all in T.32N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M. Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use. 5.37 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 22, T.34N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M. Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

9. Use will be from April 1 to October 1 of each year. Month and Day

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of Hot Springs as heretofore granted under Permit 4070, Certificate 657 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 4070, Certificate 657 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0537 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed 19.33 acre-feet per season.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 13, 1992

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 13, 1992

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 13, 1996

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 13, 1996
