hereby make application for permission to change the point of diversion of a portion

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 48910 Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.

1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.33 cfs - 38.9 mga Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Mining, Milling and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Mining, Milling & Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36 T34N, R51E, MDM at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 36 bears N35°32'29"E, a distance of 5677 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15 T34N, R51E, MDM, at a point from which the NE corner of Section 36 T34N, R51E, MDM, bears S44°55'E, a distance of 18,768 feet

7. Proposed place of use same as existing Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use Section 34, 35, 36 T34N, R51E, MDM; Sections 1, 2, 3, 10 and 11 T33N, R51E, MDM; Section 6 T33N, R52E, MDM. Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year. Month and Day

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year. Month and Day

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) drilled and cased well equipped with motor, pumps and pipeline to place of use State manner in which water is to be diverted, i.e. diversion structure.

12. Estimated cost of works \$10,000

13. Estimated time required to construct works 3 months

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies and is specifically issued contingent upon approval by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection of the dewatering project.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 40900, 47962, 48257, 48328, 48330, 48910, 48911, 48912, 49550, 49916, 49962, 51962, 52330, 52331, 52332, 52883, 52884, 53384, 53385, 54308-T, 54309-T, 54310-T, 54339, 54340, 54341, 55093-T, 55094-T, 55095-T and 55096-T shall not exceed 10,582 acre feet annually.

Any water obtained under Permits 52883, 52884, 53384, 53385, 54308-T, 54309-T, 54310-T, 54339, 54340, 54341, 55093-T, 55094-T, 55095-T and 55096-T as a result of the dewatering program by the permittee shall be used first for mining, milling, heap leaching, drilling, road water and other related mining and milling uses within the places of use as described.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of the month which shall include the amount of water pumped from each well and the amount of water used for mining and milling purposes.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345, Section 2 and will expire on August 2, 1991, at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.
