1. The source of water is Little Cedar Creek and tributaries

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 20, T.38N.,

20 bears S 29° 43' 37" W 2751.90'.

If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of Little Cedar Creek and Tributaries as heretofore granted under Permit 30772, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30772, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 5.4 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a seasonal duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 10, 1992

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 10, 1992

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 10, 1993

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 10, 1993

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 10, 1993

Completion of work filed MAY 27 1992

Proof of beneficial use filed JUL 13 1993


