hereby make application for permission to change the point of diversion and place of use

Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 52227

1. The source of water is underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.00093 cfs (0.6733 acre feet) Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for quasi-municipal and domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for quasi-municipal and domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, T.21N., R.19E., MDM, at a point from which the W 1/2 Corner of said Section 30 bears S 75 0 00' W a distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. distance of 1900.00 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 25, T.21N., R.18E., MDM; at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 26, T.21N., R.18E., MDM bears S 54 0 40' 14" W, a distance of 3760.12 feet

7. Proposed place of use within the W 1/2 Section 18; W 1/2 Section 19; portions of Section 29, 30,31,32 all in T.21N., R.19E., MDM; portions of Section 6, T.20N., R.19E., MDM; portions of Section 1, T.20N., R.18E., MDM (same as under Permit 34219)

8. Existing place of use a portion of the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 25, T.21N., R.18E., MDM containing + 19.615 acres

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) a drilled and cased well equipped with a motor, pump and pipeline to place of use.

12. Estimated cost of works \$10,000.00 completed as described above, proof of completion

13. Estimated time required to construct works to be filed upon granting of this permit

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 52227 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 52227 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 55338, 55339, 55340, 55341, 55342, 55343, 55344, 55345 and 55346 shall not exceed 22.6757 acre-feet annually.

Permits 55338 through 55346, inclusive are issued with the understanding that the place of use is the same as the place of use under permits granted to Silver Lake Water Distribution Company.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.00093 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 0.6733 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 14, 1991

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 14, 1991

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 14, 1992

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 14, 1992

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 14, 1992

Completion of work filed FEB 6 1991

Proof of beneficial use filed MAR 01 1995
