Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a portion

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 19909, Certificate 5802

Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.

1. The source of water is Underground

2. The amount of water to be changed 1.0 - c.f.s., 724 acre-feet annually

3. The water to be used for Municipal and domestic

4. The water heretofore permitted for Municipal and domestic

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., MDB&M, at a point which the East 1/2 corner of said section 7 bears North 21° 41' 00" East, a distance of 945.00 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 12, T.19N., R.19E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the East 1/2 corner of said Section 12 bears South 85° 19' East, a distance of 4623.0 feet.

7. Proposed place of use the certified water service territory of Westpac Utilities, a division of Sierra Pacific Power Company, as described in the legal description and shown on the supporting map on file with the State of Nevada State Engineers Office, Division of Water Resources.

8. Existing place of use Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13 and 14, T.19N., R.19E., MDB&M.

9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) drill, case and develop well, equip well with pump and motor, construct related facilities, and connect to distribution system.

12. Estimated cost of works \$250,000.00

13. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 3 years

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

Water will be treated at site and pumped into Sierra Pacific Power Company distribution system to serve its residential and commercial customers. During 1989, SPPCo had 52,921 customers and a maximum day delivery of 109,869,000 gallons of water.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 19909, Certificate 5802 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 19909, Certificate 5802 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is subject to the terms and conditions of the Groundwater Management Agreement between Westpac Utilities and Truckee-Carson Irrigation District dated September 5, 1991.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 724 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 23, 1992

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 23, 1992

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 23, 1995

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 23, 1995

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A


