hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

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The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 48.07 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 27, 1992

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before May 27, 1992

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 27, 1995

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 27, 1995

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 27, 1995

Completion of work filed MAY 21 1993

Proof of beneficial use filed

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use. The total combined duty of water under Permits 49792, 52455 and 55438 shall not exceed 48.07 acre-feet annually. This permit is for a new point of diversion only with no additional appropriation granted. The protest of Truckee-Carson Irrigation District dated March 6, 1991 is upheld by this action.
