POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE OF A PORTION Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use

of water heretofore appropriated under PERMIT NO. 18448 (CERTIFICATE NO. 6239) Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.

1. The source of water is UNDERGROUND Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed .0095 CFS NOT TO EXCEED .5225 MG ANNUALLY (1.6035 ACFT) Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for QUASI - MUNICIPAL AND DOMESTIC Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for QUASI-MUNICIPAL AND DOMESTIC Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point WITHIN THE SW 1/4 SW 1/4 OF SECTION 2, T14N, R18E, MDM AT A POINT FROM WHICH THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 2 BEARS S69° 30' distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. 51"W A DISTANCE OF 687.75 FEET.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within E 1/2 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 OF SECTION 24, T13N, R18E, M.D.B. & M. AT A POINT FROM WHICH THE SW CORNER OF SAID SECTION 24 BEARS S 74° 48'W A DISTANCE OF 1,359.0 FEET.

7. Proposed place of use : PORTIONS OF THE SW 1/4 SW 1/4 OF SECTION 2, SE 1/4 SE 1/4 OF SECTION 3, NE 1/4 NE 1/4 OF SECTION 10, NW 1/4 NW 1/4 OF SECTION 11; T14N, R18E, MDM. NOT MORE THAN 4.6 ACRES WILL BE IRRIGATED.

8. Existing place of use E 1/2 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 OF SECTION 24, T13N, R18E, M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

9. Use will be from JANUARY 1 to DECEMBER 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from JANUARY 1 to DECEMBER 31 of each year.

APPROVAL.....OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 18448, Certificate 6239 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 18448, Certificate 6239 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed.....0.0095.....cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 0.5225 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before.....September 30, 1992

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before.....September 30, 1994

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 55683 and 55837 shall not exceed 2.471 million gallons annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.
